Boys are encouraged to memorize God's Word each year. The verses we will be memorizing this year are provided below.

1. In the Beginning Was the Word

John 1:1 (ESV)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

2. I AM the Bread of Life

John 6:35 (ESV)

Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in me shall never thirst."

3. I AM the Light of the World

John 8:12 (ESV)

Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

4. I AM the Door

John 10:9 (ESV)

I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture.

5. I AM the Good Shepherd

John 10:11 (ESV)

I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.

6. I AM the Resurrection and the Life

John 11:25 (ESV)

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live."

7. I AM the Way, the Truth, and the Life

John 14:6 (ESV)

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

8. I AM the True Vine

John 15:5 (ESV)

I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.
