Isaiah 53:1-6

Who has believed what he has heard from us? And to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed? For he grew up before him like a young plant, and like a root out of dry ground; he had no form or majesty that we should look at him, and no beauty that we should desire him. He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not. Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

RA Patches

What are RA Patches?

"RA Patches are earned by the RA and will be awarded to the RA at an end of the year ceremony. Parents will be encouraged to attend and more information will be available on this event in the future. Below you will find a list of patches your RA may earn and descriptions of what is required to earn each patch. Patches will be sewed on the RA Shirt by the award ceremony provided the RA has earned their shirt.

RA Shirt and Patch	Attend 1/2 of all RA Weekly Meetings
Knife Patch	Complete RA Parts of the Knife Worksheet; Field ID; LADs & Crusaders will have to open and close a knife safely; Crusaders will have to find a stick and whittle 6 inches of bark off the stick
Air Rifle Patch	Complete RA Parts of the Air Ragle Worksheet; Complete Feild Safety Test; Lad's- Shoot 5 our of 10 targets with 10 tries; Crusaders- Shoot 8 our of 10 targets with 10 tries
Rope Patch	LADs- Demonstrate the ability to tie 1 of the knots taught; Crusaders- Demonstrate the ability to tie every knot taught
Bible Verse Patch	Recite all 12 verse passages from the RA Achievers list.
Race Patch	Complete an RA Derby Car and participate in the RA Race
Hike Patch	Attend and hike the entire Burkes Mountain Trail
Fish a Thon	Attend and raise money for Annie Armstrong Easter Offering (Must be one donor that is not family)
Fish a Thon Award	Most Fish Caught; Most Money Raised; Biggest Fish; Most Weight Caught
Campout	Attend and sleep overnight
Bow Patch	Complete RA Bow Worksheet; LADs will have to hit the target; Crusaders will have to hit within the 12 ring
Rod & Reel Patch	Complete RA Rod & Reel Worksheet; LADs will have to string rod, cast at target; Crusaders will have to string rod, tie lure on, cast and hit target
